

NYS COVERED ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

Computers/Laptops/CRT monitors/LCD monitors/Televisions

The following miscellaneous electronics less than 100 lbs. are also covered under NYS CEE:

Small scale servers/Keyboards & Mice/Fax machines/Scanners/Small copiers and printers/VCRs/DVD and Portable digital music players/DVD players/Digital converter boxes/Cable or Satellite receivers/Electronic or Video game consoles/Cell phones

OTHER ACCEPTABLE ELECTRONICS

Other acceptable electronics include miscellaneous electronic, metal and plastic scrap, Oversized items exceeding 100 lbs (copiers, servers racks, large printers, etc.), Medical & Scientific equipment, Cash registers, Microwaves, Typewriters, Business equipment, Misc. media and dismantled CRTs/TVs etc.

BATTERIES

The following batteries are acceptable:

*Alkaline, Nickel Cadmium, Nickel Metal Hydride, Lithium Ion, Button Cells, Lead Acid Batteries, and UPS (Uninterruptable Power Supplies)

*Unsorted batteries are subject to sorting charges.

NO OTHER BATTERIES ARE ACCEPTED.

FLUORESCENT LAMPS

Acceptable Fluorescent Lamp Material:

Fluorescent tubes - *U-tube/Circular Biax/Compact/Halogen/HID-Mercury/Metal Haloid/Hi-Lo Sodium/Coated/Shielded Shattershield/UV Fluorescent/Germicidal/Projection/Incandescent

*Non PCB ballasts, *Fluorescent/HID Fixtures

*Lamps must be packaged properly

PCB BALLASTS NOT ACCEPTED

* Broken lamps subject to surcharge



COMMINGLED PRODUCTS

Separate Container

Aluminum Cans

Tin Cans/ Containers

Plastic Bottles (shampoo, water, soda)

Plastic Tub (yogurt, cottage cheese)

Plastic Jugs (milk, juice)

TIP: Look for the code on the bottom of the
container. If it is:



PET#1

HDPE #2

LDPE #4

PP #5 or

OTHER #7 then its recyclable!!!!!!

NOTE: Remove caps. Rinse all containers.
No caps. Lids are acceptable.



OTHER PAPER PRODUCTS

Separate Container

Corrugated Cardboard

Brown Paper Bags

NOTE: Flatten cardboard. Do Not
Tie together, keep loose. No wax

Or plastic coated paper products
