AMENDING LOCAL LAW #2 OF 1977 REGULATING PARKING DURING WINTER

SECTION 1. It is prohibited for any person or persons to park or leave standing any motor vehicle, as defined in the Vehicle and Traffic Law, on any highway within the Town of Shawangunk during or immediately following a snowfall on the road surface of two (2") inches or more any time of the day during the period beginning November 1 and ending April 15 of each year. The Highway Superintendent will measure the snowfall at the highway garage and notify the Police Agencies when the snowfall reaches at least two inches.

SECTION 2. The intent of the foregoing prohibition shall be to facilitate clearing the snow and the snow removal from all roads within the Town of Shawangunk.

SECTION 3. Each violation of this Local Law shall subject the owner of the motor vehicle, or any other person operating or in charge of the motor vehicle, to a fine or penalty of not more than TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS for the first offense, TWENTY (\$20.00) DOLLARS for the second offense, and THIRTY (\$30.00) DOLLARS for each succeeding offense; and every such violator shall be deemed guilty of a traffic infraction. Such penalty shall be enforced through the issuance of a Summons by a police officer; which Summons shall be returnable before a Town Justice of the Town of Shawangunk.

SECTION 4. A violation of this local law shall also subject the owner of the vehicle or other person operating or in charge of the vehicle to the payment of all fees, including towing and storage, of the vehicle. A police officer may cause the removal from the highway of any vehicle which impedes the clearing of snow on said highway following reasonable effort made by the police officer to contact the owner of the vehicle and allowing sufficient time for the owner to remove the vehicle prior to its being impounded.
